COMPETITION FOR EXTERNSHIPS WITH INDUSTRY AND GOVERNMENT - CREATE IN MILK QUALITY PROGRAM

The CREATE in Milk Quality
program is funded by



These travel awards will be provided for one-month externships with industry and government collaborators. These travel awards are intended for Undergraduate, Master's and Doctoral students, as well as for Postdoctoral Fellows. These externships provide students and fellows with the opportunity to apply their scientific knowledge to different projects outside of academia, consolidate their professional skills, and develop their professional network. The competition is opened all year round.

General rules:

1. Must be enrolled at one of the participating universities: Université de Montréal, Université de Sherbrooke, McGill University, University of British Columbia, University of Calgary, University of Guelph, University of Prince Edward Island and University of Saskatchewan.
(A limited number of scholarships provided by *Les Producteurs de lait du Québec* may be awarded to students that are enrolled at other Universities in Quebec. For more information, please contact the program coordinator.)
2. Must have submitted an admission request to the CREATE in Milk Quality program (available at www.createmilkquality.org) and must be currently registered as an Undergraduate, Master's or Doctoral student in a graduate program or as a Postdoctoral Fellow.
3. The research project of the applicant must be in the field of bovine mastitis and/or milk quality.
4. The maximum award value is of \$2,500 for an externship of up to one month in duration (which can be divided into several week-long periods). Eligible expenses include: travel, accommodation and living expenses.

Longer externships could be considered, but will be judged on the merit of the proposed externship. An externship should improve the training experience and should not delay the expected completion date of their degree.

Application (at any time during the year):

1. Selection criteria: Quality of the project and proposed host organization (40%); training experience/relevance of acquired professional skills to your future career (60%).
2. Documents to be submitted:
 - a. Application Form, signed by the applicant and the supervisor.
 - b. A letter from the host organization confirming its commitment to host the student/fellow and a summary describing the offered externship.
